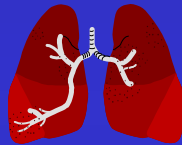

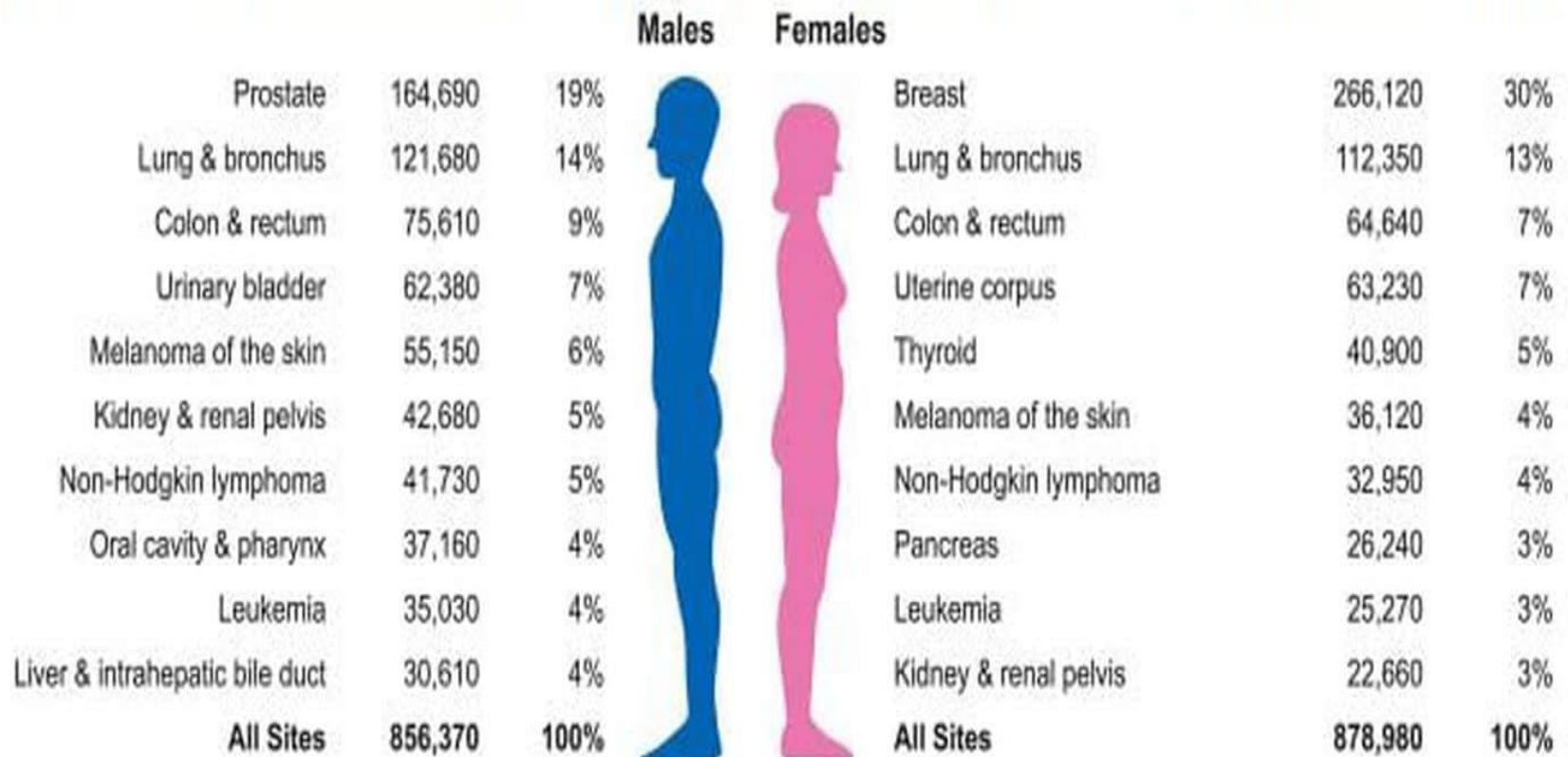

Selenium and Cancer

- **Selenium is an essential micronutrient**
- Patients with cancers - colon, breast, ovary, pancreas, the head and neck and melanoma, show lower selenium compared with healthy ones.
- **Risks are higher for cancer with lower selenium in blood.**
- **Selenium levels fall as people age.**
- Selenium enriched vegetables and grains are better chemo-preventive
- **Hershey is developing organo-selenium compounds as potential anticancer agents**

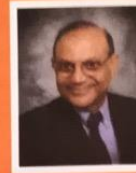
